A Guide to Making a Successful Financial Presentation

You and your colleagues have just presented an improvement initiative to the leadership team. You're optimistic and hopeful. Then, the hard questions begin. Where does the money come from to pay for all of this? Why should we devote our scarce resources to this? And perhaps the most difficult of all: Don't you understand?
